

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BILLINGS CITY COUNCIL

December 1, 2017

The Billings City Council met for a special meeting in the Community Room, at the Billings Public Library, 510 North Broadway, Billings, Montana. Mayor Hanel called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. and served as the meeting's presiding officer. Mayor Hanel gave the invocation.

ROLL CALL: Councilmembers present on roll call were: Cromley, Yakawich, Brewster, Cimmino, Friedel, Sullivan, Swanson and Clark. Councilmembers McFadden and Brown were excused.

There were no further speakers, and the public comment period was closed.


COUNCIL INITIATIVES:
