<b>PRESENTER</b>	Jeri Bucy
<b>NOTES/OUTCOME</b>	<p>Lora Mattox, Planner – Introduction.</p> <p>Jeri Bucy - Power point presentation, importance of Census.</p> <p>Tatianna Phipps – Power Point presentation, job opportunities.</p> <p>Mary Crandle – Montana Census lead representative, State Department of Commerce.</p> <p>Mayor – how to determine under and over count. Ms. Crandle - computer modeling. Spends 2 years reviewing information for accuracy after census complete.</p> <p>Mayor – counting illegal aliens impacting Montana. Ms. Crandle - questions on census literature if adequate time for reforming questionnaire.</p> <p>Ronning – 5 tribes of Montana, US does not have great history with Native Americans, why should tribes supply information?
