

Billings City Administrator Weekly Report

April 27, 2023

- 1. Meeting with County** – Tuesday morning Kevin Iffland, Bill Cole and I met with Commissioners John Ostlund and Mark Morse, and Kevan Bryan to discuss the legislative session, budgets and the jail.
- 2. Fiscal Year 2024 Budget Review and Adoption** - the Budget & Finance Committee have reviewed most of the public safety and public works budgets. They will continue working through the budget on Wednesday, May 10th and Wednesday, May 24th. City Council Budget Work Sessions begin Monday, May 1st, and continue Tuesday, May 9th, Monday, May 15th and Tuesday, May 16th. For the breakdown of each work session see the attached schedule.
- 3. Legislative Committee** – with only 8 days left in the legislative session, work is winding down. Their next meeting will be May 10. We continue to keep our eyes on legislation affecting land use, elections, tax increment financing and the budget. In the final days most of the decisions are being made in meetings or on the floor without direct access by the public. Therefore, we need to rely on conversations by phone, texts, emails and in the hallways.
