

## Billings City Administrator Weekly Report

October 6, 2023

5. **Park Bond Presentations** – Presentations were given to employees in the Water Treatment Plan and Finance.

6. **From the PIO Desk** – Nothing to report this week.

7. **New City Hall Update** - this week at the new city hall project painting of the hollow metal door frames was done and the walls on the south half of 5<sup>th</sup> floor were primed. Sheetrock on one side of the walls on 4<sup>th</sup> floor was completed and top out of the opposite side was started. Soffit and some misc framing on the 5<sup>th</sup> floor was being worked on and taping of the north half of 5<sup>th</sup> floor continues. Hydronic mains are close to being done on 5<sup>th</sup> floor and ran down to the 4<sup>th</sup> floor. Plumbing wall and overhead work is ongoing on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor. Electrical wall rough in on 2<sup>nd</sup> floor is in progress. 5<sup>th</sup> floor overhead conduit is close to complete and 4<sup>th</sup> floor continues. Demo of the last air handler in the 5<sup>th</sup> floor fans room is going well. Spiral duct over the new stair on 2<sup>nd</sup> floor was demoed and relocated. Exterior wall sheetrock and metal stud demo on the 5<sup>th</sup> floor for new windows was completed this week. Wall insulation on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor got started this week and will finish on Monday.
