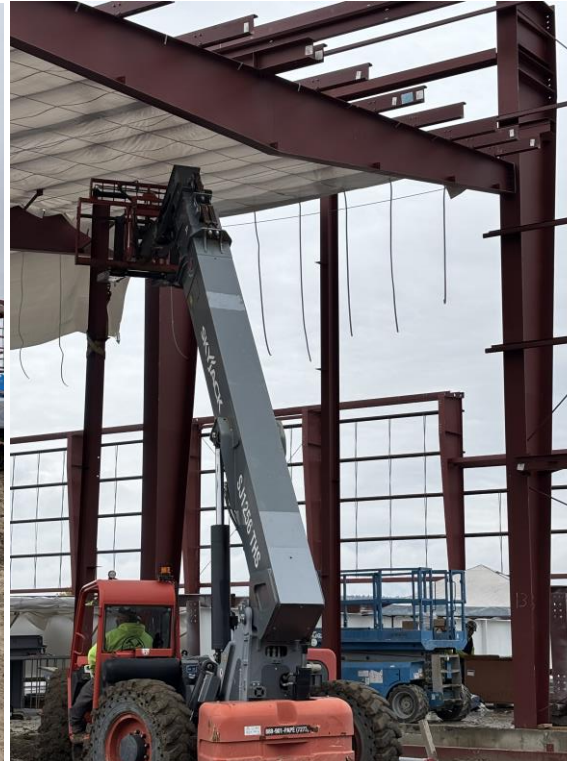

Progress Summary: Week of October 13th

- Weather: Over this past weekend, we got a lot of rain and temperatures dropped significantly. This led to a very muddy site along with it continually freezing overnight and thawing each day. The poor weather held up the erection of the trusses another week. Next week is supposed to be sunny and nice, but it is Montana, so who knows.
- Langlas: Staking out line for the NWE to come excavate along as well as the T-Tap.
- Weave: Unable to perform any work in the muddy swamp.
- J & B Erectors: (True North): Continuing to erect all steel in the lobby. The last of the steel (for the angled wall) arrived yesterday and will be erected by end of day.
- Central Electric: Began laying conduit down for the light poles and junction boxes, other than the 3 in the very east parking lot around the petroleum. No further update on what is to be done with that material.
- Painters Inc.: Painters are working on finishing up all the steel that will be hung from the roof, will start on all lower paint once trusses are attached.
- Silver Peak Framing: No work this week with the trusses still on the ground. Steel stud framing was delivered this week.

- Langlas: Once Alpine is finished up, lines will be snapped to allow for framing to being in the lobby as well as the main gym. Installing cattle guards on the south entrance to mitigate mud leaving the site.
- Weave: To begin site concrete on the south end of the ice rink and work their way west toward the basketball courts.
- Central Electric: Central to continue with the light poles.
- J & B Erectors: Main gym trusses are to be erected via crane and attached.
- Painters Inc.: Once trusses are overhead, painters will begin painting the lower parts of the steel, above 8' on all columns.
- Alpine Concrete: Alpine to be here Monday and work all week to get all the concrete polished.
- Silver Peak Framing: Framing to begin next week in both the gym and the lobby.
