I think this intersection would be a good candidate for a mini-circle combined with some bulb-outs. The combination would slow traffic along Monad, improve safety for cars turning onto Monad, and improve safety and comfort for pedestrians trying to cross Monad (which is needlessly wide at this point and oftentimes quite stressing to cross). Perhaps it would be possible to include this intersection on the future traffic calming list for consideration?
