

RESOLUTION NO. 00-17580

A RESOLUTION OF THE BILLINGS, MONTANA, CITY COUNCIL DECLARING ITS SUPPORT FOR A NOVEMBER 2000 BALLOT PROPOSAL BY THE YELLOWSTONE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS WHICH REQUESTS VOTER APPROVAL OR DISAPPROVAL OF A COUNTY-WIDE PLANNING DEPARTMENT MILL LEVY INCREASE OF 2.0 MILLS.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Billings, Montana, as follows:

WHEREAS, the City of Billings and Yellowstone County continue to experience population growth and associated increasing demands for subdivision and growth planning by the City-County Planning Department; and

WHEREAS, the Yellowstone County Planning Board is in support of placing a ballot proposal before the electorate during November 2000 which would increase the County-wide planning mill levy to 2.0 mills if approved; and

WHEREAS, the City Council concurs with the Yellowstone County Planning Board that continued demands upon the City-County Planning Department require an increase in the planning mill levy to 2.0 mills; and

WHEREAS, the authority to place such a ballot issue before the voters is conferred upon the Yellowstone County Commission.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA, AS FOLLOWS:

That the City Council hereby declares its support for the ballot proposal which would request a County-wide planning mill levy increase to 2.0 mills and the City Council strongly encourages the Yellowstone County Commission to submit this issue to the registered voters of Yellowstone County, Montana.
