

EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN

II. PROMULGATION DOCUMENT (RESOLUTION # 00-17647)

WHEREAS, all citizens and property within Yellowstone County are at risk to a wide range of hazards such as floods, fires, tornados, chemical and toxic material spills, winter storms, earthquakes, civil disorder, terrorist situations, and nuclear attack; and

WHEREAS, when such an unfortunate event occurs; local, state, and federal response agencies must be prepared to respond in a well coordinated manner by developing and using the Incident Command System to protect the public and the natural resources and minimize property damage within the community; and

WHEREAS, this Emergency Operations Plan is needed to coordinate the response of emergency personnel and supporting services of all county and municipal agencies in the event of an emergency or disaster and during the aftermath; and

WHEREAS, the Yellowstone County Disaster and Emergency Services (YCDES) Coordinator is also the City of Billings DES Coordinator.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, the Mayor of the City of Billings, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the laws of this State, do hereby adopt the Yellowstone County Emergency Operations Plan, dated October, 2000. This plan can be put into action by the undersigned, the Yellowstone County DES Coordinator, or our designee.
