

RESOLUTION 18-10727

A RESOLUTION BY THE BILLINGS MONTANA CITY COUNCIL, APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$15,000 COUNCIL CONTINGENCY FUNDS FOR THE USS BILLINGS COMMISSIONING EVENT IN SUMMER, 2019

WHEREAS, the City Council Contingency account is a means for the City Council to take advantage of opportunities or to remedy problems that could not be anticipated when the fiscal year began; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council wish to participate in and help to finance the planned commissioning in 2019 of a new U.S. Navy ship named the USS Billings; and,

WHEREAS, the estimated current year expense that is needed to prepare for the event is estimated to be \$15,000 and those funds were not budgeted in FY 2018; and,

WHEREAS, the FY 2018 Council Contingency account has a \$19,494 balance as of May 2019, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BILLINGS CITY COUNCIL THAT:

\$15,000 of FY 2018 Council Contingency funding shall be reserved or encumbered before June 30, 2018 or re-budgeted in the FY 2019 budget for supporting the USS Billings commissioning event in 2019.


