

ARTICLE II.

ZONING DISTRICTS

A. AGRICULTURAL ZONE (AG)

District Description:

The Agricultural zone district is intended to allow area for development and use of land for agricultural uses including but not limited to livestock grazing, crop production, with a limited number of types of agri-businesses as well as low density rural residential development.

B. RURAL RESIDENTIAL ZONE (RR)

District Description:

The Rural Residential zone district is intended to allow area for the use of land for rural residential development with area for limited agricultural activities including but not limited to the raising of livestock for personal pleasure, consumption or training opportunity and the raising of crops as in a hobby farm.

C. RURAL LIMITED COMMERCIAL (RLC)

District Description:

The Rural Limited Commercial zone district is intended to allow area for limited commercial development and activities focused on rural needs, including but not limited to small agricultural businesses such as veterinarians, livestock services, greenhouses, nurseries, tree farms, as well as businesses that support rural and agricultural activities such as repair shops, services businesses, artisan crafting, bed and breakfast inns and small retail shops.
