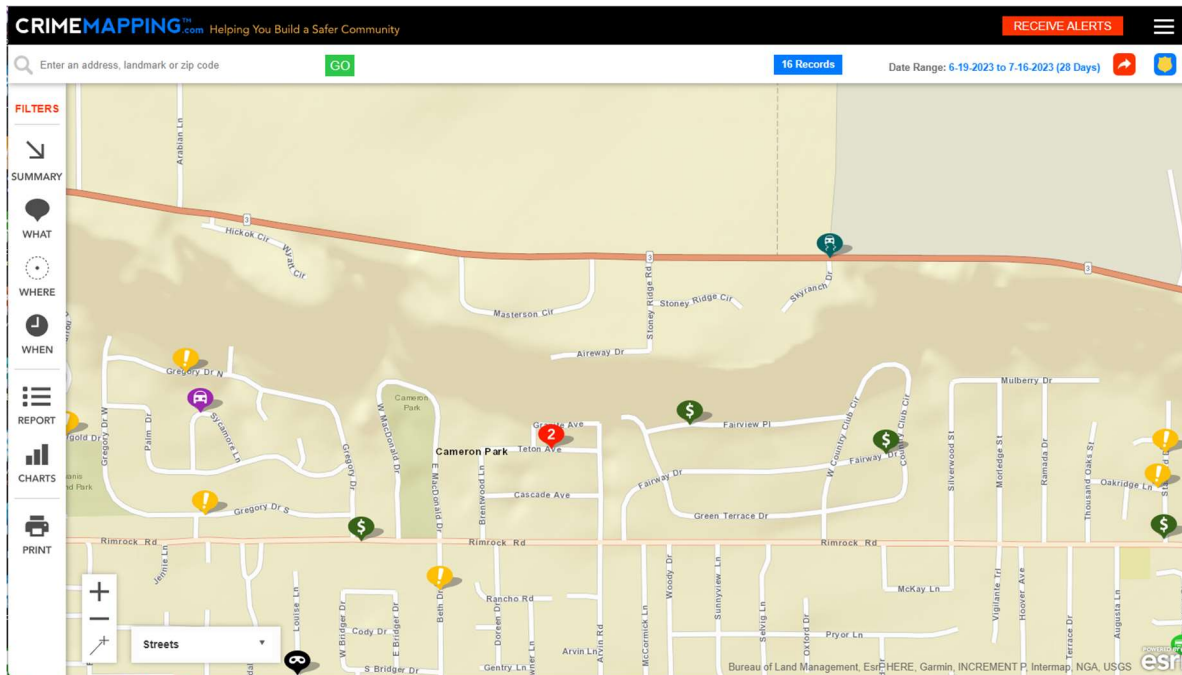

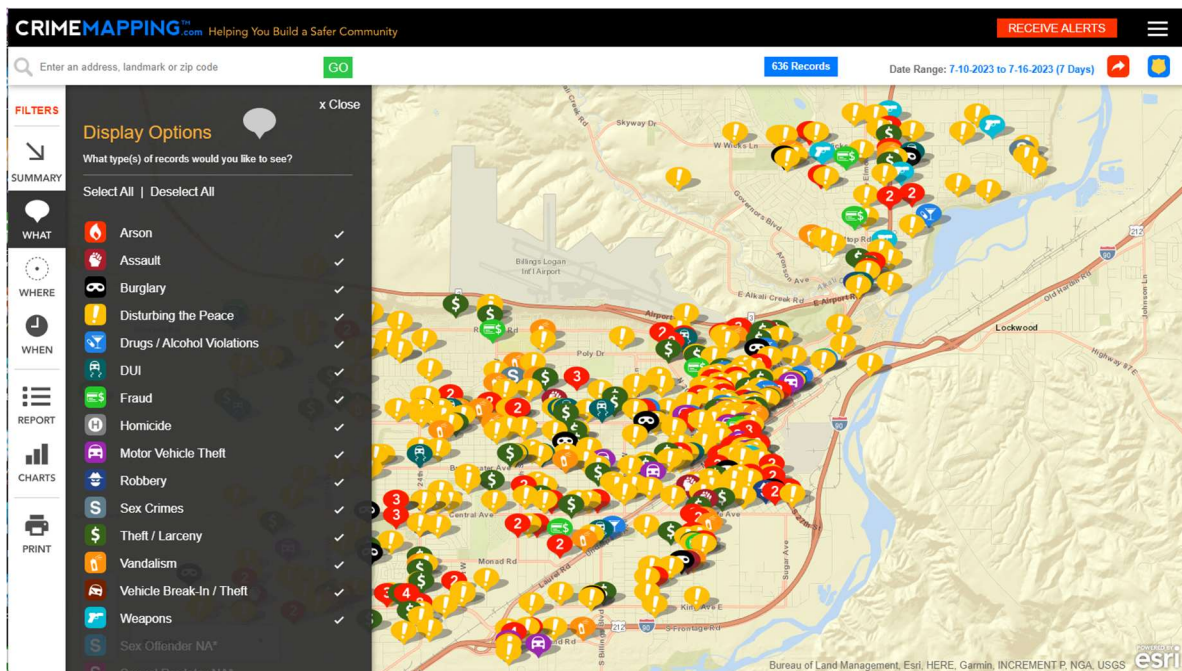
This is the home page.
