Yellowstone County Terrorism Response Plan

TERRORISM RESPONSE PLAN  
CITY OF BILLINGS

WHEREAS, all citizens and property within the City of Billings are at risk to a wide range of hazards, including but not limited to acts of terrorism against the governments of the City, County, State and the USA, and against private facilities in the County; and

WHEREAS, when such an unfortunate event occurs; local, state, federal, and private response agencies must be prepared to respond in a well coordinated manner by developing and using the Incident Command System to protect the public within the community; and

WHEREAS, this Terrorism Response Plan, which is a supplement or annex to the County Emergency Operations Plan, is needed to coordinate the response of emergency personnel of all county, municipal, medical, and healthcare agencies in the event of a terrorism or Weapon of Mass Destruction (WMD) act.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, the Mayor of the City of Billings, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the laws of this State, do hereby adopt the Yellowstone County Terrorism Response Plan, dated June 2002. This plan can be put into action by the undersigned, the Yellowstone County DES Coordinator, the Yellowstone County Health Officer, the Mayors of the incorporated cities, or their designees, or any combination thereof.
