

RESOLUTION NO. 06-18464

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA,
DISCONTINUING AND VACATING portion of Zimmerman
Trail.

WHEREAS, a proper petition was filed with the City Council of the City of Billings, Montana, as per Section 22-601 BMCC, requesting discontinuance and vacation of portion of Zimmerman Trail as described hereinafter; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was properly noticed and held as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. DISCONTINUANCE AND VACATION. Pursuant to Sections 7-14-4114 and 7-14-4115, M.C.A., portion of Zimmerman Trail more particularly described as follows:

A tract of land being a portion of Zimmerman Trail situated in the NE1/4 of Section 34, T.1N., R.25E., P.M.M., Yellowstone County, Montana, more particularly described as:

A portion of Zimmerman Trail Right-Of-Way adjacent to Lot 2, Block 1 Scott Subdivision, Recorded March 11, 1998, Under Document No. 1913900, Records of Yellowstone County, Montana, beginning at the northwest corner of said Lot 2, Block 1 Scott Subdivision; thence N 90 ° 00 ' 00 " W for a distance of 32.02 feet; thence S 00 ° 02 ' 27 " W for a distance of 99.43 feet; thence N 90 ° 00 ' 00 " E for a distance of 32.20 feet; thence N 00 ° 03 ' 49 " W for a distance of 99.43 feet to the Point of Beginning. Containing 3,193 square feet, more or less.

Is hereby discontinued, abandoned and vacated.

2. PUBLIC INTEREST. The discontinuance, vacation and abandonment of the above described portion of Zimmerman Trail is in the best interest of the public and can be done without any public detriment.
